Introducing *Principles of Liberty: Ten Biblical Truths Embedded in the Declaration of Independence*

The Word Foundations article titled "Principles of Liberty" examines the Declaration of Independence and highlights ten principles that are deeply rooted in Scripture. *Principles of Liberty: Ten Biblical Truths Embedded in the Declaration of Independence* is a five-session Bible study series that examines these principles (two per session) and uncovers the true meanings of the words and phrases most commonly quoted from America's Founding Document. The series is desperately needed right now. It demonstrates how far America has departed from the Founders' ideals, even though people often use the same words and phrases the Founding Fathers used. The study encourages a return to those ideals today. Further, it destroys some of the misconceptions commonly held about the Founders, such as the myths that they were ardent racists and "greedy capitalists." These men were not perfect, but they got a great deal right, and we need to appreciate their wisdom anew.
