ἀρσενοκοΐτης, -ου, ὁ, (ἄρσην a male; κοίτη a bed), **one who lies with a male as with a female, a sodomite**: 1 Corinthians 6:9; 1 Timothy 1:10. (Anthol. 9, 686, 5; ecclesiastical writings.)
